## Senior Citizen Lawyer Referral Program

The Burlington County Bar Association,  
through a grant from the  
Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders,  
provides legal assistance to Burlington County  
residents age 60 and older.

**Preference for service is given to those individuals  
with the greatest social and economic need.**

After an initial interview with the program staff,  
a referral is made to a program attorney. Interviews are held  
at the Burlington County Bar Association at  
45 Grant Street, Mt. Holly.

Interviews may also be conducted at the client's  
home if necessary. The program is responsible for the  
attorney's fee. However, a contribution towards the service  
based on the client's income is suggested.

Clients not eligible for the Senior Citizen Lawyer  
Referral Program will be referred to the Lawyer Referral  
Service of the Burlington County Bar Association.  
The fee for the initial consultation is \$35.

The following are PRIORITY matters handled through the program:

- Public entitlements
  - Tenant Issues
  - Mortgage Foreclosures
  - Nursing Home/Boarding Home resident's rights
  - Abuse/Neglect
  - Representation of persons proposed for or under guardianship/conservatorship
  - Medicare/Medicaid

The following NON-PRIORITY matters may be handled,  
if funding is available:

- Simple Wills for simple estates
  - Power of Attorney
  - Bankruptcy
  - Consumer contracts
  - Grandparent's rights
  - Creditor defense
  - Support/Uncontested Divorce
  - Insurance problems
- 

The following matters are **not** handled:

- Appeals
- Trusts/Living Trusts
- Estate planning
- Real estate matters
- Deed transfers
- Matrimonial matters
- Litigation out of state
- Any matter which may involve a substantial amount of available funds
- Medicaid planning to protect assets
- Fee generating cases
- Municipal court
- Small Claims Court
- Criminal matters
- Wills with many bequests or for large estates
- Litigation out of county, with exception
