Wine Column for June 2025 by Janice L. Heinold, Esq.

In May, I attended an American Wine Society tasting for the Princeton Chapter. The theme was wines from Argentina and Chile.

The first course was shrimp ceviche. Four white wines were paired with this course: 2020 Alta Vista Estate Torrontes, 2024 Carmen Reserva Frida Kahlo Sauvignon Blanc, 2023 Altaland Chardonnay, and 2022 Montes Alpha Chardonnay. Due to the citrus-y nature of the ceviche, the Torrontes and the Sauvignon Blanc were the best wine pairings. The Chardonnays, while decent, were not acidic enough to stand up to the ceviche.

The 2020 Alta Vista Torrontes is from Argentina. Torrontes is a white grape variety grown almost exclusively in Argentina. The best Torrontes come from Salta in the Mendoza region, as this one does. Torrontes is a highly aromatic grape, with good acidity yet rounded mouthfeel. It pairs naturally with



seafood. This bottle had aromas of white flowers and honeysuckle on the nose, and flavors of orange and lemon on the palate. This is probably the last year this wine should be held until, as it's already 5 years old, and it's produced to be consumed young. 14.5% ABV; available for \$19 at Bottle Republic.

The 2024 Vina Carmen Reserva Frida Kahlo Sauvignon Blanc paired the best with the shrimp ceviche, in my opinion. Vina Carmen is considered the oldest winery in Chile, founded in the Central Valley in 1850 by Christian Lanz. Lemon, honeysuckle, white flowers, and some grassy notes on the nose continued on the palate, and reminded me more of a Bordeaux Sauvignon Blanc than a New Zealand one. 12.5% ABV; a steal for only \$15 at Total Wine and More.

The second course was grilled flank steak with chimichurri sauce, roasted potatoes, and green beans. Four red wines were paired with this course: 2023 Vina Carmen Gran Reserva Carménère, 2019 Alta Vista Alizarine Malbec, 2019 Mascota Vineyards Unamine, and 2022 Lapostolle Cuvée Alexandre Cabernet Sauvignon. The Unanime and the Cabernet Sauvignon were the best pairings with the steak.

The Mascota Vineyards Unanime Gran Viño Tinto is from the Uco Valley in Argentina. Comprised of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Malbec, and 15% Cabernet Franc, all sustainably-farmed. Aromas of licorice, blueberry, black currant, and dried herbs combine with silky tannins and a lengthy finish. A great value for \$25.99 at Total Wine and More.

Lapostolle Winery is in the Apalto region of the Colchagua Valley of Chile, located about two hours south of Santiago, between the Coastal Cordillera mountain range and the Pacific Ocean. Their grapes are 100% hand-harvested, and the vines average 60 years old. The 2022 Lapostolle Cuvee



Alexandre Cabernet Sauvignon contains grapes from the El Condor vineyard, which is protected on three sides by hills, and on the fourth, by the Tinguiririca River. The Cuvée Alexandre contains 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Carménère, and 2% Petit Verdot aged in French oak barrels (17% new, 83% second-fourth use) for 14 months before bottling. Aromas of fresh cherries and black currants continue on the palate, with a longer, complex finish. This was my favorite wine of the tasting, and a steal at \$23.99 from Total Wine and More. 14.5% ABV.

I have to admit I don't drink a lot of South American wines, but I was impressed with the quality and values of these wines. ¡Salud!

What The IRS Wants To Know About Attorneys & The Way You Practice

A few years back, Marty Abo presented a seminar for the New Jersey State Bar Association and several local bar associations with the caption above. Now, we weren't trying to scare anyone, but did you know there is a special IRS manual dealing exclusively in auditing lawyers? Frankly, we thought the presentation was of interest for attorneys from large firms, smaller firms, practicing solo, and even inhouse counsel who think they might eventually retire and hang up a shingle, part-time or full-time. We wanted to share our insight and to show some of the actual tools the IRS use and even by oversight departments, like the Office of Attorney Ethics (OAE) here in New Jersey.

Anyway, we thought it's a good time to revisit the topic as they had updated the attorney audit technique guide in the interim. Anyone wanting a copy of the audit guide needs only to request it from us.

The IRS's Market Segment Specialization Program (MSSP) focused on developing highly trained examiners for a particular market segment. A market segment may be a profession, such as what we are focusing on in this article, or industries like construction, retail, or entertainment, or perhaps an issue like passive activity losses. The MSSP is an auditing approach used by the IRS since 1993 and is designed to examine and evaluate how businesses operate. It divides taxpayers into industry-specific segments rather than groups based on the type of return or income level of the taxpayer. Agents are trained in certain areas of business or market segments, which IRS believes will result in more effective audits and improved audit selection.

An integral part of the approach used was the development and publication of Audit Techniques Guides. These Guides contain examination techniques, common and unique industry issues, business practices, industry terminology, and other information to assist the IRS in performing examinations.

They put together officers to determine what type of audit issues exist.

Agents have been trained in specific market segments, such as attorneys, to become specialists in those areas. They then conduct audits within that market segment regardless of the form of organization, whether it is a proprietorship, partnership, S corporation, C corporation, limited liability company, or trust.

Sooo...A FEW PASSING OBSERVATIONS REGARDING THE ATTORNEY AUDIT GUIDE

- Sources of returns selected for examination include Martindale Hubbell Directory, yellow pages, county and state bar directories, nonfiler programs coordinated with states, and from other IRS examination groups, including C.I.D.
- Examinations appear concentrated on smaller firms where internal controls tend to be lax.
- Examiner's concerns arise with funds or other forms of income bypassing the general account. For example, some attorneys have cashed trust or fee checks or deposited them directly into personal or investment accounts. The lawyer's particular specialization also grabs the attention of examiners (i.e. personal injury practice more prone to result in client costs advanced adjustment; criminal and immigration attorney's increased access to cash receipts; real estate attorneys may receive deeds in lieu of fees; security or tax attorneys may receive an equity interest for services rendered; legal services performed for non-deductible products or services received in barter, etc.).
- Examiners are utilizing available audit techniques to identify the law firm's attempt to defer income by allowing fees to remain in the trust account until the following year.
- As the MSSP training manual for attorneys points out, the initial interview by the examiner is perhaps the most important step of the audit process. You'll want to take a look at the IRS's Initial Interview Outline to illustrate just how industry and lawyer-specific their probing has become.

Although our primary attention here has been with the audit training guide focusing on lawyers, we should mention that the IRS has identified an exhaustive and ever-growing list of industries, businesses, and issues for which it has or will be developing similar guides. As of April 30, 2025, we noted 26 such audit guides in use.

In the ad for the seminars, I suggested that the attendees bring their accountant and, if they wouldn't pay for the accountant to come, I offered to. Regardless, you may wish to take your CPA out to lunch and go over the entirety of the guide with him or her. Just sayin'...






