The Past

In 2012 forward thinking leaders of the Burlington County Bar purchased condominium space at 137 High Street, 3rd Floor in Mt. Holly in the Foundation's name to house the offices of our Association and Foundation. The purchase was intended to improve our ability to further the missions of serving the attorneys of Burlington County, improving the administration of justice, and fostering and maintaining the honor and integrity of the profession of the law. A fundraising campaign sought to fund the purchase of the space as well as equip it with the appropriate furnishings needed to provide the programs and services envisioned. Despite the generosity of our donors and monthly mortgage payments made over the past five years, the Bar currently owes a balance of approximately \$150,000.

The Present

President Heinold has made it a primary goal of his administration to eliminate the mortgage. A new fundraising committee has been created, consisting of five Past Presidents of the Association. We seek a contribution from every member of the Association. Your generous help is vital to achieving this goal!

The Future

- Unencumbered by a mortgage, the Bar Association's presence in historic Mt. Holly, the county seat, will be easier to maintain in future years.
- The offices will continue and improve visibility of the Association and Foundation within the community and among the public.
- The offices will continue to serve as a "home away from home", providing deposition and meeting room capabilities for our members, and a place where members can work or relax between court appearances.
- A mortgage-free office adds to the financial viability of the Association by ending its "rental" obligations to pay a sum needed for the mortgage owed by the Foundation, enabling more money to be spent for its programs.
- A mortgage-free office enables the Foundation to spend more time on its charitable purposes rather than on administrative action assuring the payment of the mortgage.
